## **Important information for insulin users: Change of reimbursement for certain insulins with effect from 19 September 2022**

We will be changing the subsidy for certain insulins with effect from 19 September 2022.

On the back page, you can see whether this affects your treatment. If your insulin is not mentioned on the back page, you do not have to do anything.

If your insulin is on the yellow list, you will still receive reimbursement for your insulin if your doctor finds that you meet certain conditions (clauses). You usually qualify for this if you are already being well treated.

If your insulin is on the red list, you will no longer be eligible for automatic reimbursement, but, in special cases, your general practitioner can apply for reimbursement on your behalf.

### **Consult your GP**

If your insulin is listed on the back page, you must consult your GP about your future treatment so that you can still receive reimbursement for your insulin after 19 September 2022. For example, you can do this at your next scheduled control visit or the next time you need to renew your prescription. Your GP has also been informed about the changes.

### **Why are we changing the reimbursement?**

We are changing the reimbursement because some insulins should only be used by certain patients or because one insulin is more expensive than another, which is just as effective.

**NB!: If you are being treated with an insulin that is on the below lists, you need to consult your GP about your future treatment before 19 September 2022.**

**If you use one or more of the following insulins, your GP will assess whether you are covered by the corresponding clause (the yellow list).**

Name	You are covered by the clause if:
