For products for which the electronic upload cannot be made by the date of the first yearly signal detection review on EVVET in 2022, MAHs will be invited for the first yearly signal management update to upload a line listing to EVVET of all non-serious reports since the last PSUR DLP up to 28 January 2022.



- Medically impotant VeDDRA terms list (MI) terms identify serious medical concepts. Tool for prioritisation
- Emerging safety issue (ESI) (3 days) impact b/r

- Upcoming detailed manual
